Impartation

The Effortless Way to Receive Grace Gifts

Romans 1:11 For I long to see you *so that I may impart some spiritual gift to you*, that you may be established;

Impart: to share, grant, convey something from one vessel to another...

There are three keys we must possess in order to place ourselves in a position to be imparted to from another

Be Humble:

James 4:6 But He gives a greater grace. Therefore [it] says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE."

Philippians 2:3 KJV - [Let] nothing [be done] through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind *let each esteem other better than themselves*.

Romans 12:10 NLT - Love each other with genuine affection, and *take delight in honoring each other*.

Romans 12:3 For through the grace given to me I say to *everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think;...*

Give Honor to Whom Honor is Due:

Galatians 6:6 The one who is taught the word is to share all good things with the one who teaches [him.] **7** Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.

Romans 13:7 Render to all what is due them: tax to whom tax [is due;] custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; *honor to whom honor*.

Hunger for righteousness:

Matthew 5:6 KJV -Blessed [are] they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

Psalms 23:5 You *prepare a table* before me in the presence of my enemies; You have *anointed my head* with oil; *My cup overflows*.

Martha and Mary: - Mary chose the part that will not be taken away from her...

Acts 2:3 And there appeared to them tongues as of fire *distributing themselves*, and they rested on each one of them.

- The question is not: did the fire fall, it did
- The question is: what kind of dwelling place are we preparing for it?
- **The goal is not to admire the fire but to become the fire!**

Woman with the issue of blood:

Luke 8:45 And Jesus said, "Who is the one who touched Me?" And while they were all denying it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing in on You." **46** But Jesus said, "Someone did touch Me, for I was aware that power had gone out of Me."

- **Though there were many people touching Jesus only this woman experienced the power of Jesus flowing from Him into her**
- **This is the act of impartation**

Blind Bartimaeus:

Mark 10:46 Then they came to Jericho. And as He was leaving Jericho with His disciples and a large crowd, a blind beggar [named] Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the road. **47** When he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

- **Though many were shouting and even crying out "Jesus", Bartimaeus called Jesus by His Messianic name, "Son of David".**
- **This means Blind Bartimaeus knew the anointing on Jesus, and this enabled him to receive the impartation from Jesus that he needed.**
